At the Governor's second Cabinet Meeting on November 6th at the Cozy in Thurmont, four LEO Club's Presidents reported on their size, completed activities and plans for the future during this school year. Three LEO Club presidents-- Mt. Airy Middle School 8th grader Ashley Hobbs, Thurmont Middle School 8th grader Kiley Warner, and Liberty High School LEOs senior Kelsey Hof—made heart-warming reports about their community service activities. In one way or another, these LEOs are focused on feeding hungry families and providing clothing and toys to kids for Christmas.
