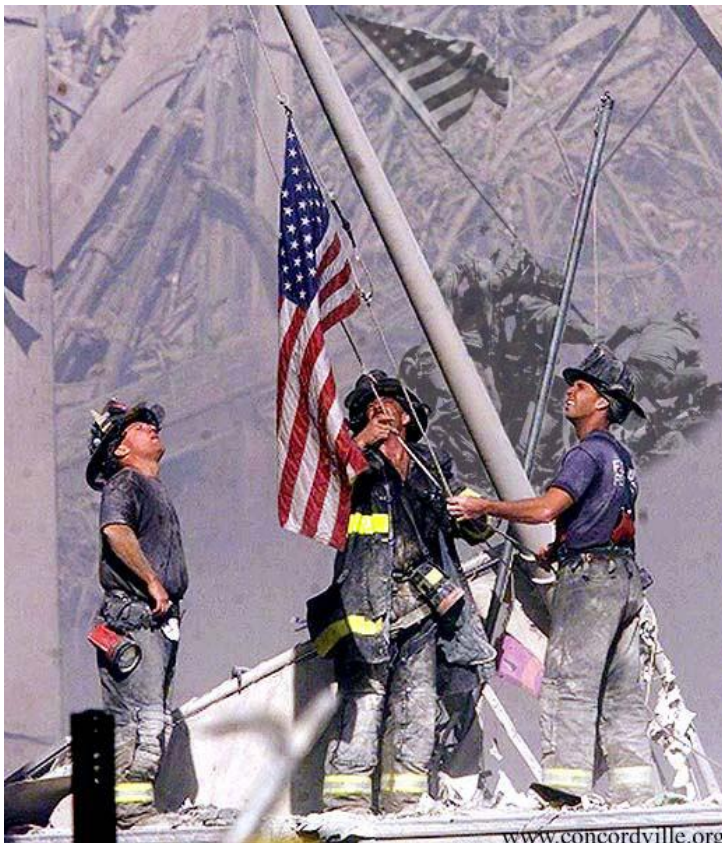

## **Facts about the 9/11 - NEVER FORGET**



- ❖ The planes hit the towers at very high speeds. Flight 11 was traveling roughly 490 mph when it crashed into the 1 WTC, the north tower; flight 175 hit 2 WTC, the south tower, at about 590 mph.
- ❖ The jet fuel probably burned out in less than 10 minutes; the contents of the buildings burned over the next hour or hour and a half, according to the lead investigator of the NIST investigation.
- ❖ 2,749 death certificates were filed relating to the WTC attacks, as of February 2005.
- ❖ 23 New York City Police Officers died on September 11th, 2001.
- ❖ The New York City Fire Department lost 343 firefighters, almost half the number of on-duty deaths in the department's 100-year history.
- ❖ The fires at Ground Zero burned for 99 days, until Dec. 19.



## **Did You Know**

- ❖ Our club logged total of 314 volunteer hours for the month of August!
- ❖ The first observance of Labor Day is believed to have been a parade on Sept. 5, 1882, in New York City, probably organized by Peter J. McGuire, a Carpenters and Joiners Union secretary.
- ❖ By 1893, more than half the states were observing a "Labor Day" on one day or another, and a bill to establish a federal holiday was passed by Congress in 1894. President Grover Cleveland signed the bill soon afterward, designating the first Monday in September as Labor Day.
